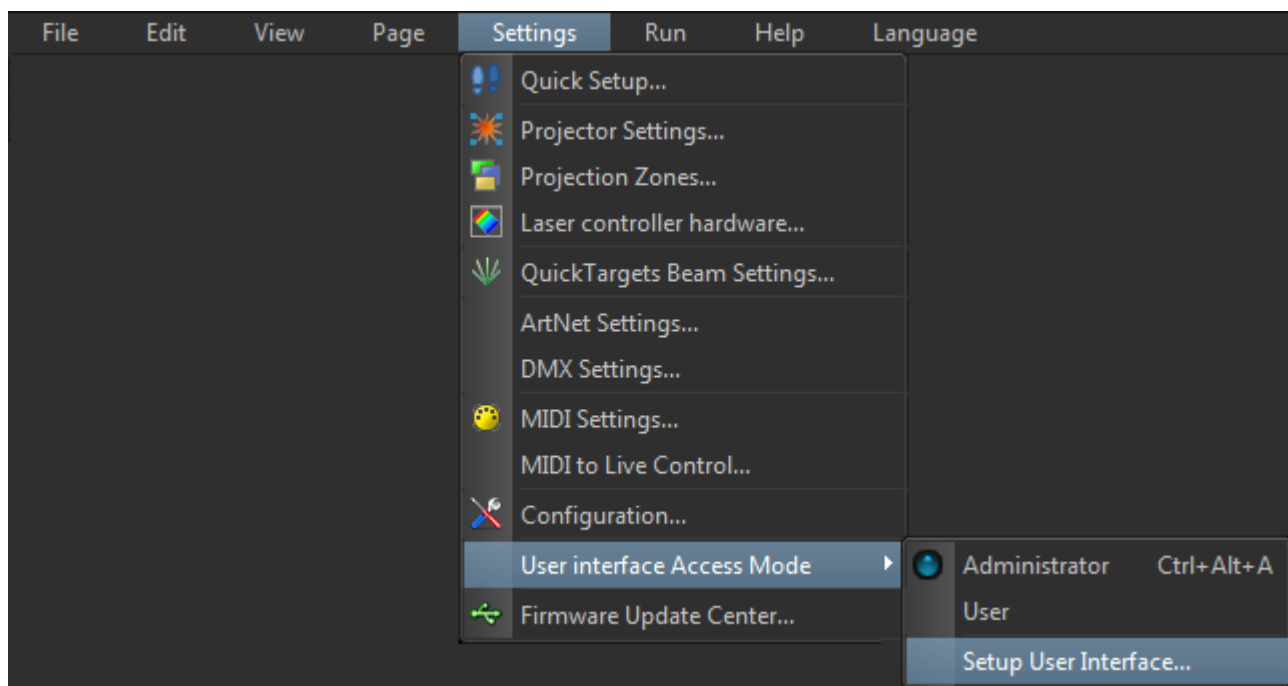


User-interface Access Mode

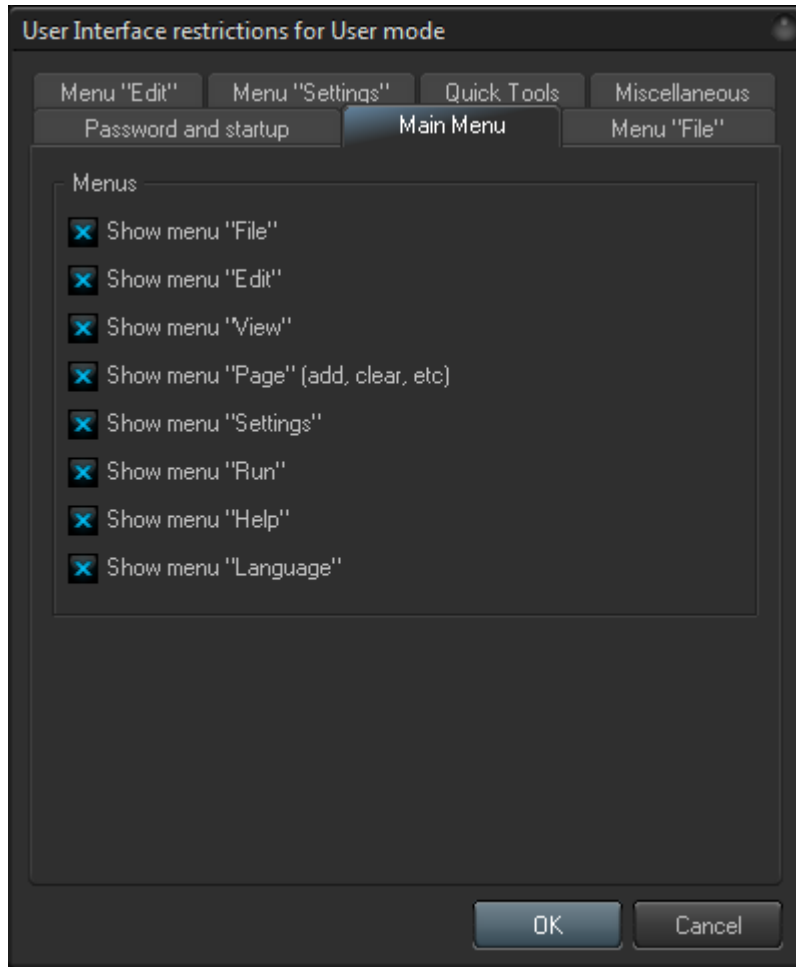
There may be times when you want to restrict access to certain parts of BEYOND. One case would be in a disco with a “light jockey” operator. He or she may not need to access all of the creation or cue editing features of BEYOND and instead would only need to trigger the already-setup cues and perhaps access a few Live Control features. For that reason, BEYOND provides a facility that allows you to indicate which features you want available in the “User mode”.

Setting up the User-mode restrictions

To setup the User-mode restrictions, go to the Settings menu, and choose Setup User Interface as shown below.



A dialog box will appear which allows you to control all aspects of the user interface, and also specify a password which must be used in order to go from User mode back into Administrator mode.
